Chenn.AI connected: Tamil Nadu plugs into Google's AI mainframe

Collaboration to power AI startups, supercharge workforce skills, and drive MSME tech adoption

Chennai, 1 September

It is time for Chenn.AI in Google's artificial intelligence (AI) road map now. The global major has signed a deal with the Government of Tamil Nadu and the AI ecosystem in the state.

With this partnership, the company aims to skill 2 million youth in AI via Naan Mudhalvan, collaborate with startups, and enable micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) and the rural economy with advanced technology.

On Sunday, Tamil Nadu secured a ₹400 crore investment from US-based Ohmnius International to set up a manufacturing facility in the state. Chief Minister M K Stalin is currently on a visit to the US seeking investments.

The Google deal comes after Alphabet — Google's parent company — lined up its plans to manufacture Pixel smartphones in Tamil Nadu in a tie-up with Foxconn. This will be done at a former Nokia campus in Siperumbudur, located 40 kilometres southwest of Chennai. Apart from smartphones, the US technology giant is also going to start manufacturing drones in the state through its subsidiary Wing LLC.

Google on Saturday exchanged a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Tamil Nadu government to drive technological advancement and foster innovation in the state.

"CM's visionary Naan Mudhalvan, which is India's largest upskilling initiative, aims to equip the youth of Tamil Nadu with future-ready AI skills and spark innovation across key sectors such as startups, mobility, health care, and other real-world challenges. The state is committed to equipping 2 million youth with cutting-edge AI skills to prepare them for the future. We look forward to exploring initiatives with Google under this programme," he added.

"We're thrilled to partner the Tamil Nadu government on their journey towards an AI-powered future. This collaboration underscores our shared commitment to fostering inclusive growth and technological progress through AI. We look forward to working together to build a thriving AI ecosystem in Tamil Nadu — one that not only drives innovation and creates opportunities but also empowers individuals with the skills they need to succeed in the digital age," Zavery added.

Google and the Government of Tamil Nadu are exploring collaborations regarding the manufacturing of Pixel 8 phones. The Made in India Pixel 8 devices are being manufactured in Tamil Nadu through local partnerships. Google will collaborate with the government to upskill Tamil Nadu's workforce with AI capabilities and explore AI learning initiatives under the flagship Naan Mudhalvan upskilling platform.

The MoU exchange took place in Google's Mountain View office in the presence of Stalin and Industries Minister T R B Rajaa.

Amit Zavery, vice-president (V-P) and head of platform at Google Cloud, and Nanda Ramachandran, V-P of the Pixel business unit at Google, were also present.

Under the MoU, Google will work with Guidance, the Tamil Nadu government's nodal agency for investment promotion and facilitation, to support the development of a robust AI ecosystem. This includes providing access to advanced technologies and resources, with an

emphasis on empowering individuals, businesses, and government entities to leverage AI for inclusive growth and progress.

"We are happy to collaborate with Google on advanced manufacturing, including the recently announced Made in India Pixel 8 phone being manufactured in Tamil Nadu. The MoU signed will explore key AI initiatives under the Tamil Nadu AI Labs. Our partnership with Google is a big step forward towards establishing Tamil Nadu as a thriving AI and advanced electronics manufacturing hub. We are not just adopting technology; we are harnessing its

resources. We will be coming out with single and user-friendly forms," said a person privy to the development.

The Shram Suvidha portal was launched in October 2014 to consolidate information on labour inspection and its enforcement, leading to transparency and accountability in inspections.

The portal provides a platform for sharing of information among the four labour enforcement agencies — Chief Labour Commissioner (CLC), Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS), Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) and Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC), thus facilitating effective enforcement of labour laws on wage, job and social security for workers.

"The new labour codes have provision for single returns, single licence, single registration form. So, whenever the new codes kick in, it's important that we have the necessary infrastructure to implement the provisions and help businesses in compliance," the person said.

The Samadhan portal was launched in September 2020 and, according to government data, nearly 63,000 complaints have been filed till June 2024, out of which 45,600 complaints have been disposed of.

"In the new version, there will be provisions for sending out alerts to workers whether they are receiving timely wages, bonus amounts and other social security benefits. This will let workers better know of their rights and will help them in filing complaints in case there are violations," the person said.

Earlier in July, while presenting the Union Budget, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced that as part of labour-related reforms, the two portals will be revamped.

"Shram Suvidha and Samadhan portals will be revamped to enhance ease of compliance for industry and trade," she had said.

The labour ministry is set to launch a revamped, user-friendly version of the Shram Suvidha portal by the end of the year to aid in improving the ease of doing business.

The upgraded portal will leverage artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning (ML) to make it easier for businesses to file all kinds of registrations and submit returns that are required under different labour laws, people aware of the matter told *Business Standard*.

"We are in the process of revamping the portal to make it much easier for businesses to use and also help us in enforcing the laws. The idea is to leverage data and help businesses in complying with the different provisions of the laws so that they can better utilise their
